READING POINTS

Students in grades 8-12

Read or listen to any book, graphic novel, or work of fanfiction for points, as long as it is middle school reading level or above and 50 pages or more (15,500 words for fanfiction). Turn in this log every 25 points for an entry into the grand prize drawing of a \$50 Amazon gift card. All entries are due by August 7.

BOOK POINTS:

50-100 pages = 1 point
101-200 pages = 3 points
201-300 pages = 5 points
301-400 pages = 8 points
401-500 pages = 10 points
501-600 pages = 13 points
601-700 pages = 15 points
701-800+ pages = 18 points

FANFICTION POINTS:

15,500-25,125 words = 1 point
125,126-50,125 words = 3 points
50,126-75,125 words = 5 points
75,126-100,125 words = 8 points
100,126-125,125 words = 10 points
125,126-150,125 words = 13 points
150,126- 175,125 words = 15 points
175,126-200,126+ words = 18 points

LISTENING POINTS:

1 hour = 1 point
2 hours = 3 points
3 hours = 5 points
4 hours = 8 points
5 hours = 10 points
6 hours = 13 points
7 hours = 15 points
8+ hours = 18 points
